The Office of Juvenile System Oversight (OJSO) conducted an unannounced visit on November 19, 2008, at the Oklahoma School for the Blind. During the visit, the OJSO spoke with administrators, staff, and residents; reviewed documents and files; and toured the facility buildings and grounds.
