General Information

The Office of Juvenile System Oversight (OJSO) conducted an unannounced visit on November 16, 2006, to the Robert M. Greer Center, located in Enid, Oklahoma. This was the second unannounced visit in 2006. The center is a specialized facility for persons with a dual diagnosis of mental retardation and mental illness. The purpose of the visit was to assess compliance with established responsibilities and facility policy and procedures. The facility was licensed by the Oklahoma State Department of Health for fifty-two residents. On the day of the OJSO visit, the facility had one resident under the age of eighteen.

Overview

Interviews

The OJSO interviewed the only juvenile resident who resided at the Greer Center. No concerns were noted from the interview.

One staff member was interviewed. No concerns were noted from the staff interview.

File Reviews

The file on the current juvenile resident was reviewed. The OJSO did not note any concerns with the resident file review.

One staff file was reviewed. The OJSO did not note any concerns with the personnel file review.

Observational Tour

The OJSO conducted a tour of the facility. Findings were noted on the OJSO Facility Inspection Form. (Attached).

Summary

On the day of the OJSO visit, the Robert M. Greer Center provided a positive and professional environment. The Greer Center only had one resident under the age of eighteen, who will turn eighteen in May 2007. The facility findings were discussed during the exit conference. The team manager agreed to correct the issues within thirty days.

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
